NAME:	Moderate hemophilia A
DESCRIPTION:	A moderately severe form of hemophilia A characterized by factor VIII deficiency (biological activity between 1 and 5 IU/dL) leading to abnormal bleeding as a result of minor injuries, or following trauma, surgery or tooth extraction. Spontaneous hemorrhages are rare. The condition primarily affects males but may also be observed in female carriers of disease-causing mutations.
