NAME:	Hemochromatosis type 5
DESCRIPTION:	A rare hereditary hemochromatosis characterized by mild to moderate late-onset iron overload with increased serum ferritin, normal or high transferrin saturation, and increased liver iron concentration. Associated laboratory findings are more pronounced in males than in females.
