**Pseudo-von Willebrand disease**

<b>NAME:</b>	Pseudo-von Willebrand disease
<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	A bleeding disorder characterized by mild to moderate mucocutaneous bleeding, which becomes more pronounced during pregnancy or following ingestion of drugs that have anti-platelet activity. This disease is due to hyperresponsive platelets, resulting in thrombocytopenia.
