**Centripetalis recessive dystrophic epidermolysis bullosa**

<b>NAME:</b>	Centripetalis recessive dystrophic epidermolysis bullosa
<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	Centripetalis recessive dystrophic epidermolysis bullosa (RDEB-Ce) is an extremely rare subtype of dystrophic epidermolysis bullosa (DEB, see this term), characterized by blistering which begins acrally and then progressively spreads toward the trunk.
