**Syndactyly type 3**

<b>NAME:</b>	Syndactyly type 3
<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	A rare non-syndromic syndactyly characterized by complete and bilateral syndactyly between the 4th and 5th fingers. In most cases, it is a soft tissue syndactyly, but occasionally the distal phalanges may be fused. The middle phalanx of the fifth finger is usually hypoplastic, and the feet are not affected.
