NAME:	Lymphedema-posterior choanal atresia syndrome
DESCRIPTION:	A rare genetic disease characterized by choanal atresia and early onset of lymphedema of the lower extremities. Additional reported features include facial dysmorphism (hypertelorism, broad forehead, smooth philtrum, unilateral low-set ear, and high-arched palate), hypoplastic nipples, and pectus excavatum.
