NAME:	Fleck corneal dystrophy
DESCRIPTION:	Fleck corneal dystrophy (FCD) is a rare generally asymptomatic form of stromal corneal dystrophy (see this term) characterized by multiple asymptomatic, non-progressive opacities disseminated throughout the corneal stroma with no effect on visual acuity.
