DESCRIPTION:	A rare X-linked syndromic intellectual disability characterized by a variable clinical picture including developmental delay, mild to moderate intellectual disability, learning difficulties, communication deficits, and behavioral problems (such as aggression, attention deficit, hyperactivity, and autistic features). Personality disorder and psychotic behavior have also been reported.
