NAME:	Glycogen storage disease due to muscle phosphofructokinase deficiency
DESCRIPTION:	Muscle phosphofructokinase (PFK) deficiency (Taru's disease), or glycogen storage disease type 7 (GSD7), is a rare form of glycogen storage disease characterized by exertional fatigue and muscular exercise intolerance. It occurs in childhood.
