

Indications for prenatal Rasopathy panel testing

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1. NT is ≥ 3.5 mm

and one of the following ultrasound anomalies is present:

- distended jugular lymphatic sacs
- hydrops fetalis,
- pleural effusion,
- ascites
- cardiac anomalies,
- renal anomalies.
- Polyhydramnios

OR

2. isolated increased NT of ≥ 5.0 mm.
