

Indications for prenatal Rasopathy panel testing

prepared by the BeSHG Prenatal Committee on 18.06.2020 approved by the College for Medical Genetics on 04.09.2020

1. NT is ≥3.5 mm

and one of the following ultrasound anomalies is present:

- distended jugular lymphatic sacs
- hydrops fetalis,
- pleural effusion,
- ascites
- cardiac anomalies,
- renal anomalies.
- Polyhydramnios

OR

2. isolated increased NT of \geq 5.0 mm.
